We work hard at Heacham Infant and Preschool to make sure we have a broad curriculum that covers not only learning but wider personal development. We have strong provision for personal development at our school with planned and spontaneous experiences, roles and responsibilities open to all our pupils. The Nest and Sparrows

In sparrows this half term we have been learning about lots of different fairy tales. Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, The Gingerbread Man, Jack and the Beanstalk and more. The children have tried porridge for snack, made their own gingerbread and planted their beanstalks. We have looked at weight, height and different sizes. The children have used lots of mathematical language. The children have retold stories, and incorporated elements from the stories in their role play.

Goldfinches

We have had a great half term, learning about special places in London and other parts of the UK. We know the king has a palace in London and a house in Sandringham too. We sent him some pictures. I wonder if he will reply?

Next half term we will be thinking about different types of transport, vehicles and emergency services.

Kingfishers

This half term we've designed and made smoothies in DT, learning about being healthy. Maths lessons have been busy measuring mass and length, counting to 50 and using our number bonds. We learnt the story of The Crow and the Peacock and wrote our own stories with a moral - be happy with who you are. Geography lessons have been exploring the UK and we've made connections to Ireland, Scotland and Wales. In RE we've learnt some Bible stories which help us think about friendship and how being a good friend is sometimes easy and sometimes more difficult. We've also been really busy becoming readers and learning out Set 3 sounds. We are aiming to be speedy with these by Easter! If anyone needs some speed sound cards for practising at home, please let Miss Bennett know. We are very proud of Kingfishers and the excellent learning they have been doing.

Owls

Owls are continuing to work hard and enjoying working in smaller groups with Mrs Gee! In English the children are learning how to write instructions on 'How to Look After a Pet Dragon!' We even had a message from a dragon to ask us to think of a list of things we would need to look after them. In maths we have been looking at measures, measuring length and height, mass and capacity. In Science we have enjoyed learning all about the human body. We investigated how food travels through our digestive system, it was very messy and fun!

In art we have been learning about portraits and self portraits. We looked at the artist Picasso and created our own style cubism portraits. They look great! In Geography we have been learning all about the British Isles and have enjoyed finding out lots of new facts.

We would like to wish you all a lovely half term. We look forward to welcoming you back in a week.

The importance of good attendance

The Government strives for every pupil to achieve 97% attendance. Every day away from school is a day away from learning and this can have an impact on a child's education and future accomplishments.

We want every child to enjoy school and achieve their potential in education and life beyond. We are always here to talk through any issues and help find solutions. Parents are always a phone call away if a child is too ill to continue their day, please encourage them to try to give the day a go, children often feel much better once they are in class.

The Government has issued new attendance guidance and targets to all schools, you may receive regular texts informing you of the number of days that your child has been absent in a term/year. The Government hope that this personal approach will make parents more aware of how the odd day adds up and help keep you informed.

PUNCTUALITY MATTERS!

Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning:

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year.
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.
- Arriving 30 minutes late every day is the same as being absent for 19 days a year.

19 days lost a year through being late means 90% attendance.
